2020 UPDATE INFORMATION, DATES, VENUES AND RULES

Your updated 2020 Trampoline & DMT League handbook will be available shortly. The information given below is to give you advance notice of any changes that will be implemented in 2020. All other rules will remain unaltered.

LEAGUE DATES 2020

Firstly please find the dates and venues of our 2020 provision below;

League 1 Qualification Event - April 4th / 5th - The Triangle

CLUB TEAMS

The inclusion of club teams at events adds another dimension to club inclusivity, team work and performance. In 2020 we would like to acknowledge clubs entering sufficient numbers to create a team in each competition group in our results. So, if a club enters three or more competitors in one competition group, the top three ranked from each club will automatically constitute a team, and the teams will be ranked in the results. You will not be required to nominate your teams.

In 2020 there will be no team awards but if this initiative is popular we will look for sponsorship in order to provide team awards for 2021.

RULE CHANGES FOR 2020

The League is a non profit making organisation and everyone who helps at the League is a volunteer. Unfortunately in order to cover costs in 2020 we are required to raise entry fees.

Entry fees will rise by £2.00 across the board.

We apologise for having to do this. The new entry fees are shown below -

5.5.1. - QUALIFICATION EVENTS

- Entry into 1 individual event - £24.00
- Entry into 2 individual events - £38.00
- Entry into 3 or more individual events - £50.00
- Entry in the DMT and TRI Cups - No charge
- TRS is charged independently of the above structure. Entry into TRS is £26.00 per pair

5.5.2 - LEAGUE FINALS

- Entry into 1 individual event - £37.00
- Entry into 2 individual events - £56.00
- Entry into 3 individual events - £65.00
- Entry into 4 individual events - £74.00
- Entry into the DMT and TRI Cups - No charge
- TRS is charged independently of the above structure. Entry into TRS is £26.00 per pair.

The entry cost for spectators to the events will increase slightly and the price will be given in the event specific information.

6.2.6 - SUPER LEAGUE TRI RULE CHANGE

The Super League event is a great opportunity to compete against the League's best 15+ competitors as well as competing in age group. This opportunity allows competitors to expand their capabilities and improve stamina by doing more than one event, all with the additional excitement of cash prizes for the top 3 competitors in each event.

The basic rules remain the same, but there is now no requirement to have a minimum of one element with a minimum of 720° somersault rotation in the first routine. As before in order to preserve the higher level of the Super League there is an overall requirement for a competitor to have executed a minimum of 4 different elements of a minimum of 720° of somersault rotation in the preliminary rounds. None of these may be repeated.

If a competitor fails to compete with 4 different elements of a minimum of 720° of somersault rotation in the preliminary rounds they will receive a 2 point penalty from the Chair of Panel for each missing element.

Other than the additional requirement above the rules for Super League are the same as the League 1 - 17+ FIG A requirements (see League handbook 6.2.5).

6.2.7 - TRAMPOLINE CUP

The Trampoline Cup is an exciting knockout initiative introduced into the League in 2019. The top 8 preliminary scorers from all League 1 (15+) and Super League events are invited free of charge to enter the knock out event. The winner of the Trampoline Cup receives a cash prize.

In 2020 we are refining the event as follows:-

- a) In the first round of the Trampoline Cup (quarter final) competitors will compete with three elements. All three elements will be judged with difficulty added to the score.
- b) In the second round of the Trampoline Cup (semi finals) competitors will compete with five elements. All five elements will be judged with difficulty added to the score.
- c) In the final round of the Trampoline Cup the finalists will compete with ten elements. All ten elements will be judged with difficulty added to the score.
- d) In order to promote execution excellence the event will be judged by three execution judges with the middle score tripled. All execution scores will be from 10 with difficulty, HD and Time of Flight added.
- e) Full Trampoline Cup rules can be found in the 2020 handbook.

6.5 - ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR THOSE COMPETING IN THE DISABILITIES CATEGORIES

We would like to build the numbers competing in our D.T. categories. In order to encourage particularly those who may have difficulty in learning or retaining routine sequences, from 2020 all those competing in the D.T. categories may have their routines called out with no penalties incurred.
